Tackling racism remains one of the key challenges for our society.

Since the EU referendum there has been a significant increase in reported hate crimes in Britain. We have also seen racism come to the fore elsewhere – in the populism of Donald Trump, the police brutality in the US, the mistreatment of refugees. Yet in each case there has also been resistance to the racism.

This major national conference brings together speakers, organisations and activists from anti-racist campaigns across Europe to build on the struggle against racism.

It will examine the current challenges in Britain and beyond such as the fight against Islamophobia and antisemitism; the defence of civil liberties and migrants rights; the development of solidarity with the Black Lives Matter movement in the US; and the resistance to the rise of the far-right across Europe.

The humanitarian crisis in Europe will also be discussed, with the intention of developing an action plan for activists and organisations who want to campaign for more to be done for refugees.

Themes include:

- Brexit: Defend migrant rights and freedom of movement
- From the US to Britain – Black Lives Matter
- Refugees welcome here
- Prevent, the Extremism Bill and the defence of civil liberties
- From Trump to UKIP – opposing right wing populism
- Europe and the renewed threat of fascism and the far right
- Love Music Hate Racism
- Austerity and the rise in racism
